THE Ballyclough Springmount Dairies 10 mile road race was held in Mallow on Sunday last. The race, promoted by the Mallow Athletic Club, was a huge success with over 170 athletes taking part in the event. The day itself was too warm for running as most of the finishing times were slow. Athletes came from all parts of Munster and Galway. The race was started by Donie O'Mahony at West End. There the runners made their way up O'Brien Street, then up the Convent Hill where there was a group of about 10 runners broke away from the field. The climb up the Iron-

mines took its toll amongst the runners until they came to the flat. The winner of the race was a top-class runner, John Fitzgerald of Clonmel with Denis McCarthy of Youghal 2nd and John O'Halloran of West Tipperary Harriers in third. The first Mallow man home was Pat Kerrigan in 13th place, with Jim Moran in 16th, Andy Neenan finished 20th. The ladies section was won by Marion Lyons of St. Finbarrs, with Fionagh McMorrough of Galway second and Mary Murphy of Mallow third. Noreen Nagle finished in 7th place and Catherine O'Callaghan in 10th. In the vets section we had

Donal Kiely winning the over-55s. The athletes were presented with medals and certificates after the race. Timing of the race was done by Keanes of Cork.
